



 Treaty of friendship and trade between Japan and Prussia in 1861

- Düsseldorf as the centre of Japanese foreign trade in Germany
- Increase in Japanese demand for engineering and heavy industry products from NRW

- Technological progress and rise of Japan's export economy
- Establishment of a network of Japanese organisations in Düsseldorf

- Foundation of NRW Japan K.K. in Tokyo in 1992
- Preliminary peak in settlement cases with 502 Japanese companies in NRW in 1991


